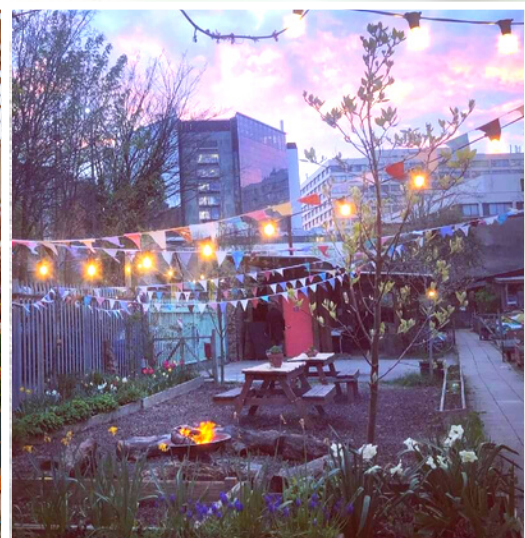


Oasis Farm Waterloo

Oasis Farm Waterloo is a vibrant community garden & city farm hidden behind the Waterloo rail bridges, run by the charities Oasis Hub Waterloo & Jamie's Farm.

The pocket-sized farm hosts an eclectic events programme alongside an outreach programme helping vulnerable young people reengage with education. This combination means all the profit from events and hires goes directly back into our schools and community work .

Event hires have access to our wifi, a basic PA system (including microphones), and a large screen television for presentations. If it suits your event we can also organise a volunteering session for everyone to get ‘stuck in’ to farm life, although this is for smaller numbers.

WEDDINGS

Weddings at Oasis Farm Waterloo allow you to create a celebration that is as individual as you are. The space is generally hired as a blank canvas, you can bring in the decor, catering and trimmings that suit your vision. Alternatively, we can recommend trusted caterers, florists and bands to create a package for you.

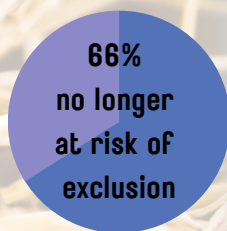
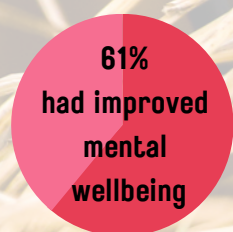
We do regularly work with some amazing live bands who perform at our events. If you'd like a recommendation for music we're more than happy to give you ideas.

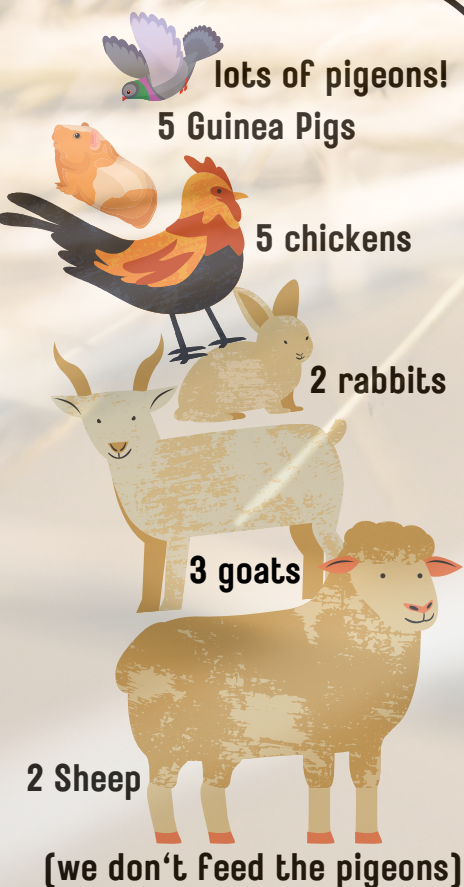

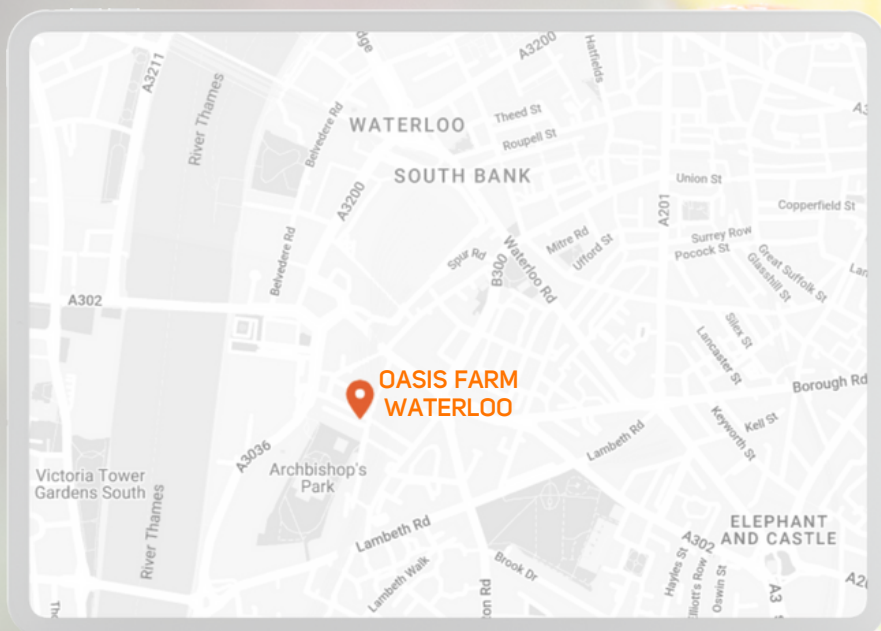
